

RESOLUTION NO. 395

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SIX-YEAR STREET PLAN
FOR THE CITY OF McCLEARY, REPEALING
RESOLUTION 380, AND PROVIDING FOR AN
IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

R E C I T A L S:

WHEREAS, the City Council and Mayor have received the recommendations of the City Engineer and Director of Public Works as the result of the receipt of additional information as to the fiscal aspects of the funding involved with the implementation of certain of the projects contained within the six-year street plan; AND

WHEREAS, this information was not available at the time of the adoption of Resolution 380, the resolution adopting the six year street plan for the current period and it is the desire of the Council and Mayor to incorporate this additional information within its programs; AND

WHEREAS, the City has been informed that the governmental agencies to which this document is provided for utilization in their work have requested that the City reflect this additional information through the modification of its existing resolution; AND

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to formally adopt those recommendations as they have been recommended by the City Engineer and Director of Public Works, subject to the modifications and expansions carried forth by the Council and Mayor, through the repeal of Resolution 380 and the adoption of this resolution in its stead; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McCLEARY, THE MAYOR CONCURRING:

SECTION I: That certain listing of streets, funding and the priorities established thereon attached hereto as Attachment Number 1 and incorporated by this reference shall be and is hereby adopted as the six-year street plan for the City of McCleary, as that plan is required and designated by the appropriate divisions and agencies of the State of Washington, including but not limited to the Department of Transportation.

SECTION II: The Clerk-Treasurer and the City Engineer shall provide such distribution of this Resolution as may be required from time-to-time.


SECTION III: Resolution 380 shall be and is hereby repealed as of the effective date of this resolution.

SECTION IV: The effective date of this resolution shall be the date and time of approval by the Mayor, following its adoption by the Council.
