

RESOLUTION NO. 270

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING MUNICIPAL SONG.

R E C I T A L S:

1. McCLEARY is a municipal corporation organized under Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington.

2. The Washington State Legislature has carried forth a significant amount of research in attempting to determine the appropriate musical composition to designate as a State song.

3. At this time, the Legislature is considering designation of at least two songs, specifically, Roll on Columbia and Louie, Louie.

4. McCLEARY has undertaken the same type of review and has determined that it would be inappropriate to designate as its municipal song Roll on Clouquallum.

5. The City wishes to utilize the extensive research carried out by the State in this matter and this seems to indicate there remains one best choice as a municipal song.

6. There is present within the municipal government a significant number of individuals to whom first knowledge came not as a result of a golden oldie weekend, but rather as being there at the beginning as one of the top 40 being promoted in 1962 by George Barner and the Corvettes.

7. The City Council, with the Mayor concurring, wishes to designate, with a certain amount of light heartedness, a municipal song.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McCLEARY, THE MAYOR CONCURRING:

SECTION I: The classic Louie, Louie is hereby designated as the municipal song of the City of McCleary to be utilized for popular purposes under such circumstances in which Wagner's Twilight of the Gods would be inappropriate.

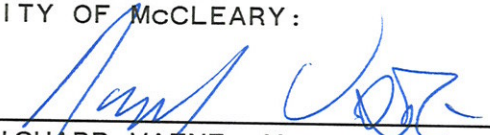
SECTION II: The municipal song shall be utilized at such times and under such circumstances as may be determined necessary and appropriate by the City Council or Mayor and shall continue to be so designated until further action of the Council.

SECTION III: Mr. George Barner, former teenage idol and current middle-aged political leader, is invited to appear at the McCleary Bear Festival for purposes of formal inauguration of the designation of a municipal song.

SECTION IV: The Legislature of the State of Washington is congratulated for its work up to this point in designation of a State song and is encouraged to consider formally designating Louie, Louie as at least the alternate or popular State song.

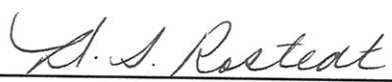

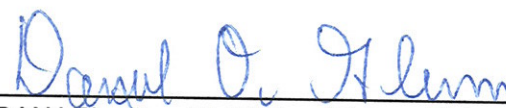
