

WHEREAS pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 195 of the 1961 Session Laws of the State of Washington, the Town of McCleary did prepare a comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years, AND,

WHEREAS pursuant further to said law, the Town Council of the Town of McCleary being the legislative body of said Town did hold a public hearing on said comprehensive plan at 7:15 o'clock P. M., at the Town Hall in McCleary, Washington, on the 26th day of December, 1961.

WHEREAS there were no written or oral objections to the comprehensive plan as prepared by the Town of McCleary relative to the street program for the ensuing six years within the Town of McCleary.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of McCleary, that the comprehensive plan as prepared by the Town Engineer for the Town of McCleary as submitted to the Town Council of the Town of McCleary be and the same is hereby adopted, public hearing being held on the same on the 26th day of December, 1961, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock P. M., and there being no written or oral objections to said comprehensive plan,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of said comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years together with a copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of Highways of the State of Washington.
